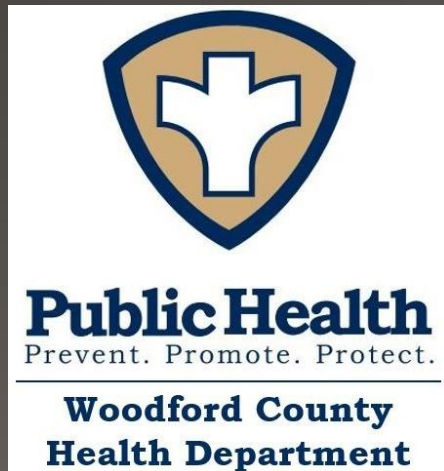


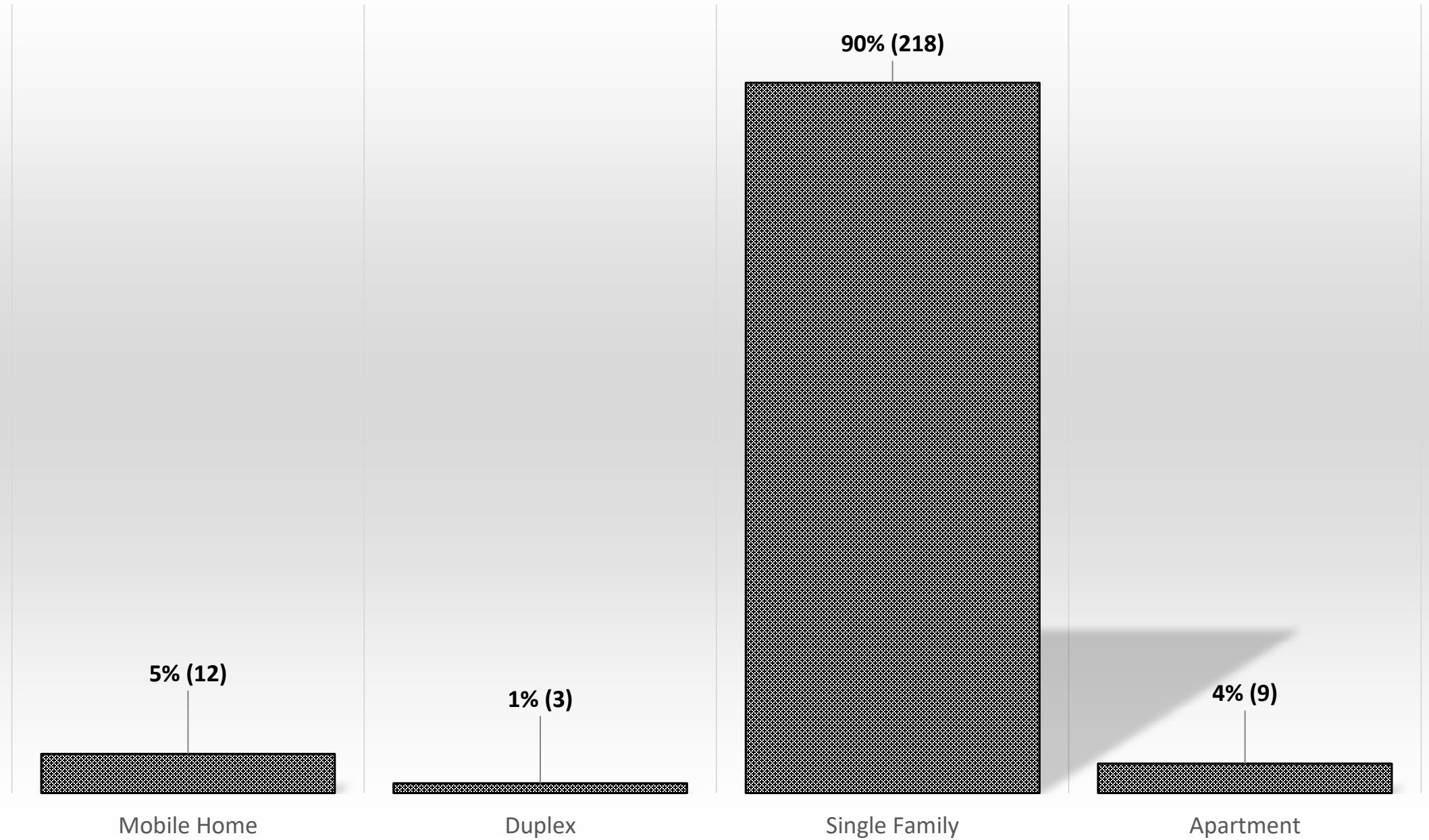

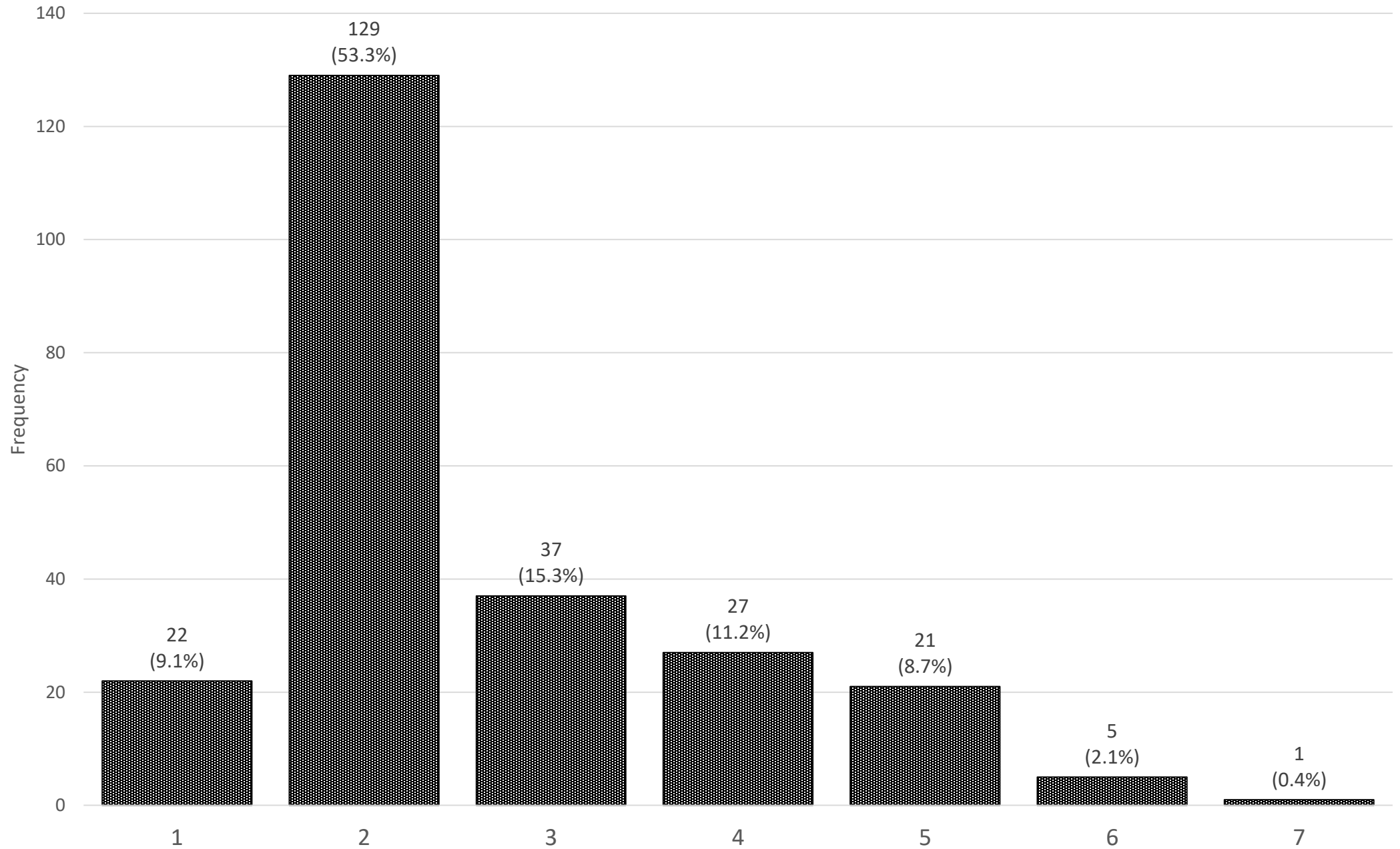

Household Type

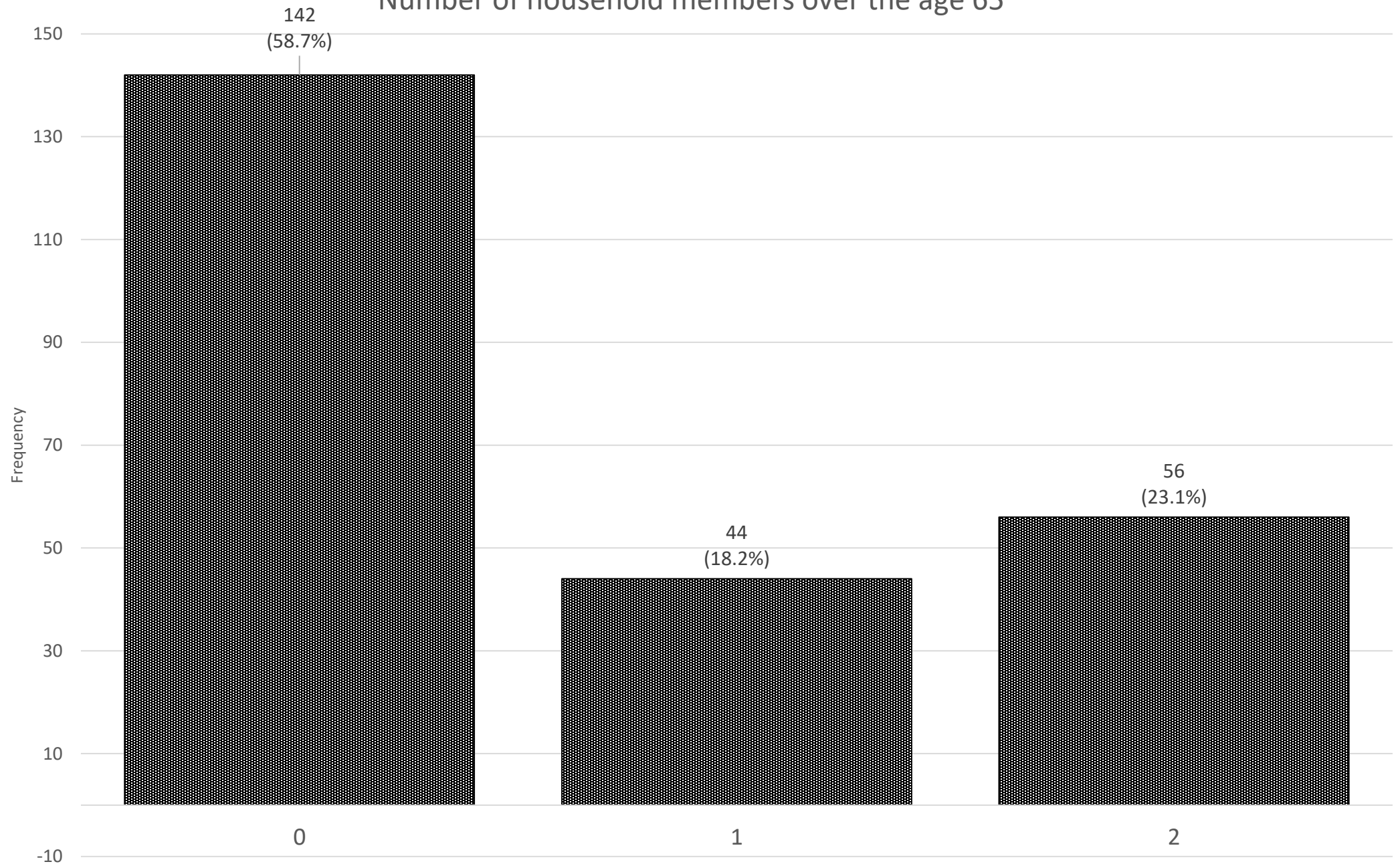


Number of people in the household



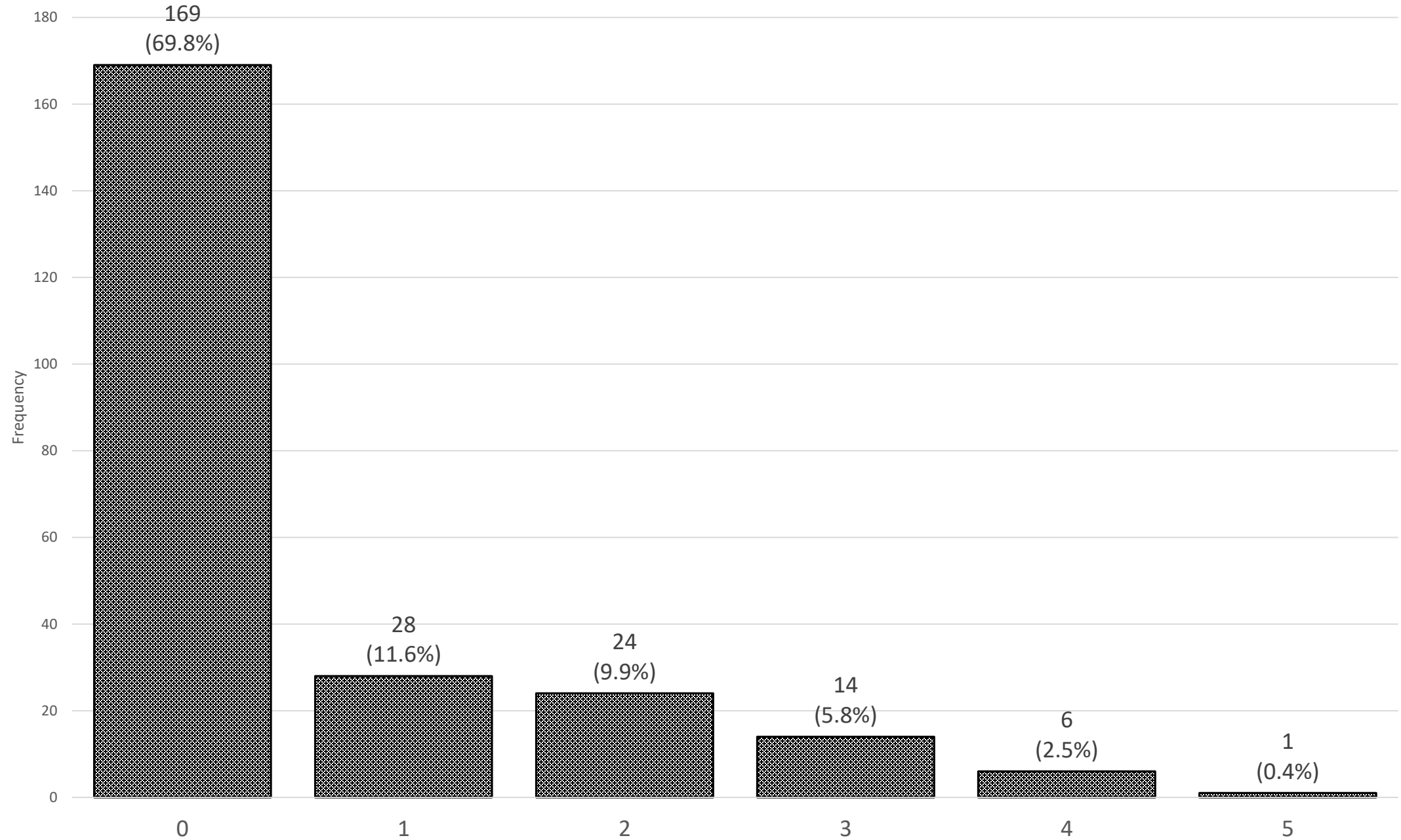

Number of household members over the age 65



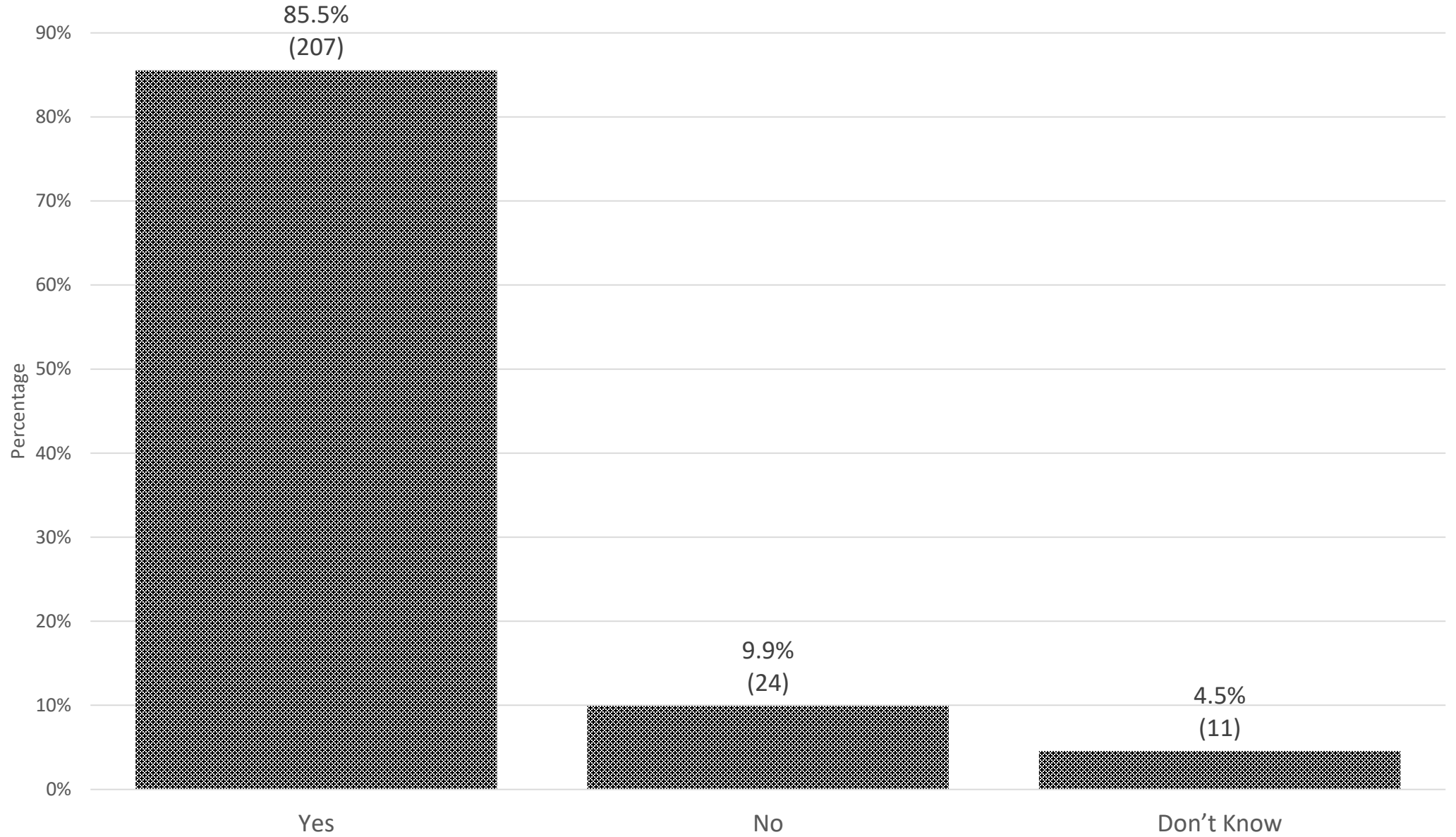

Number of household members under the age 18



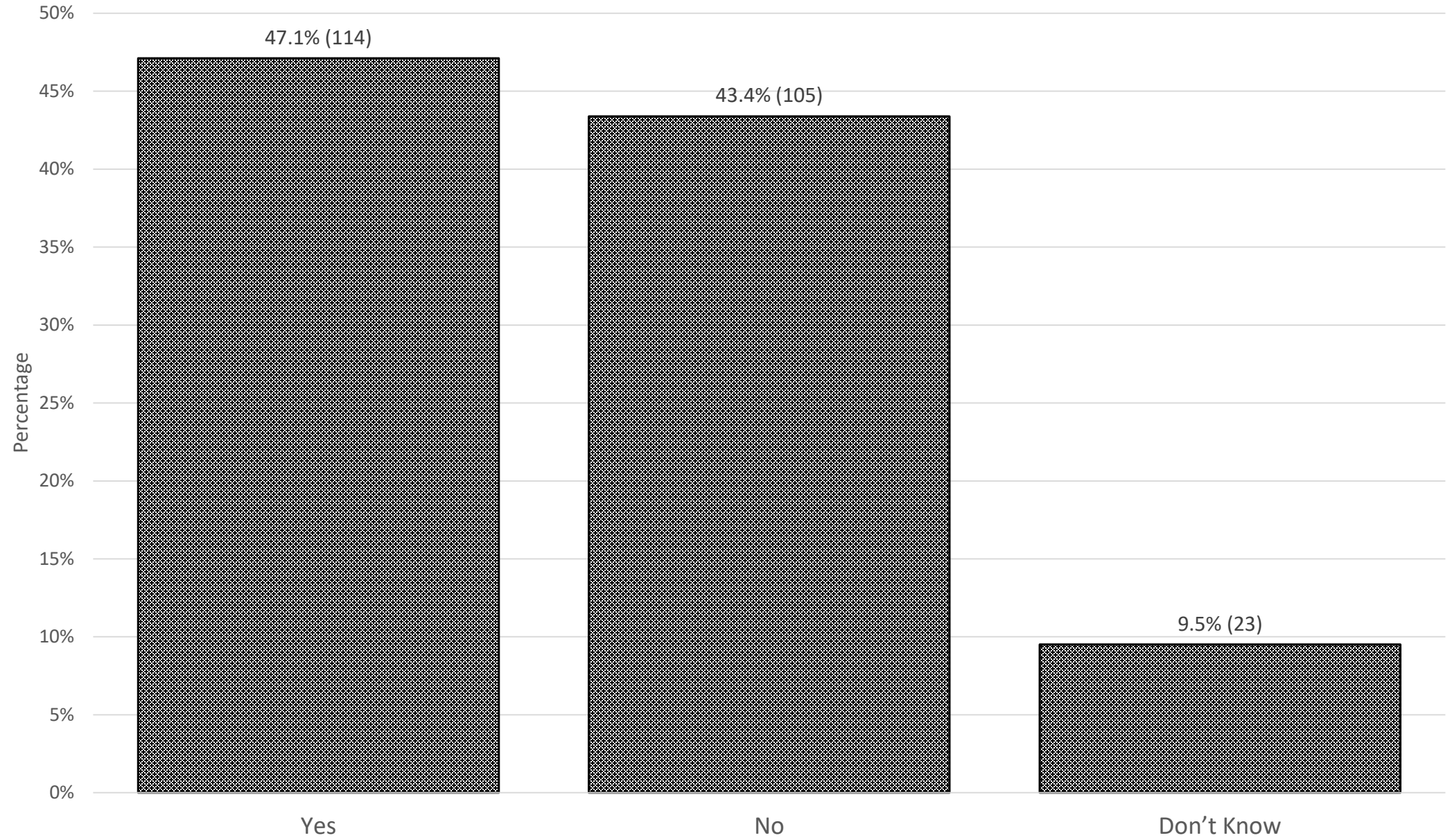

Are you and the members of your household aware of the health effects of radon?

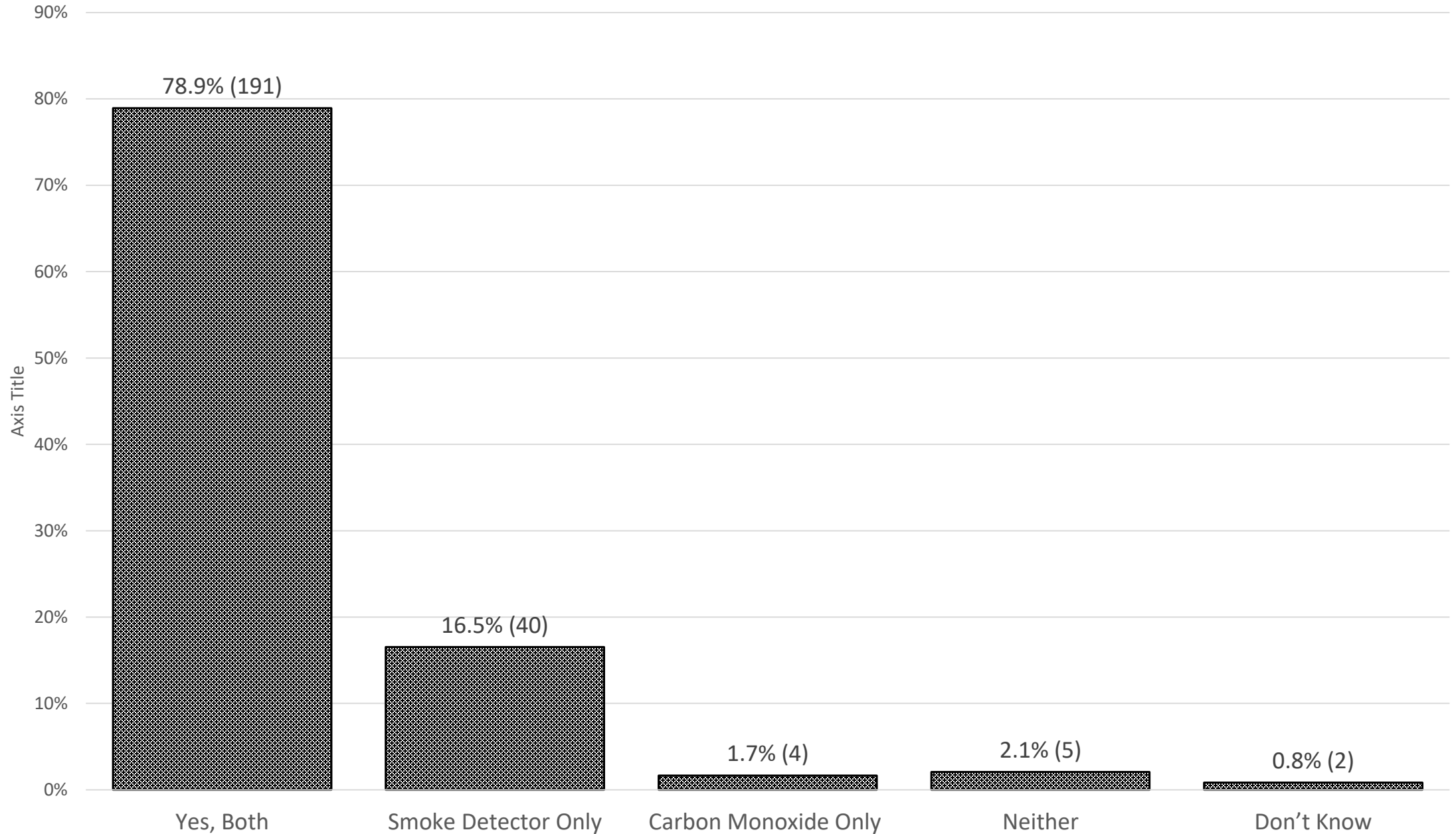

Has your home ever been tested for Radon?

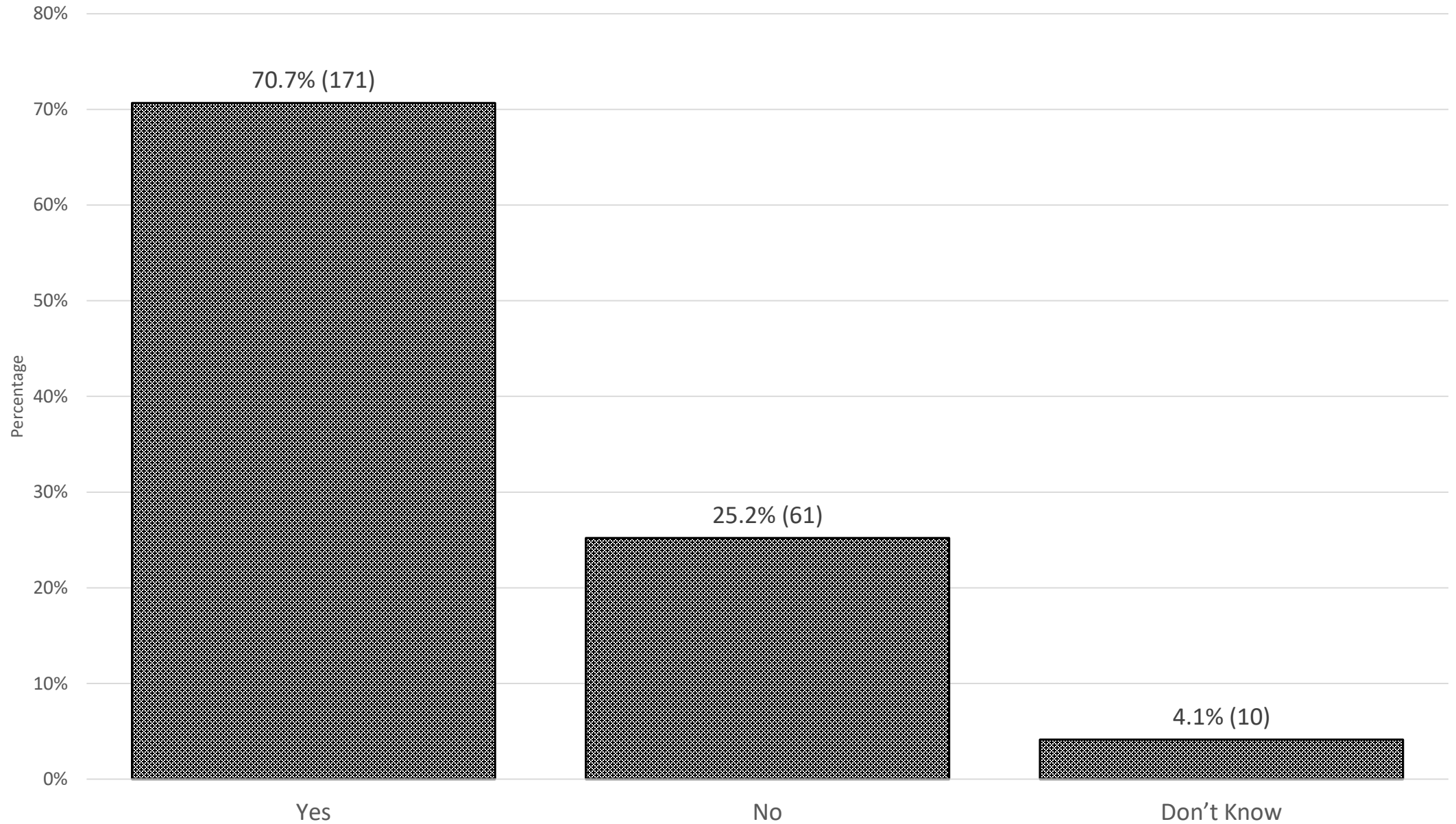


Does your household have a Smoke and/or Carbon Monoxide Detector



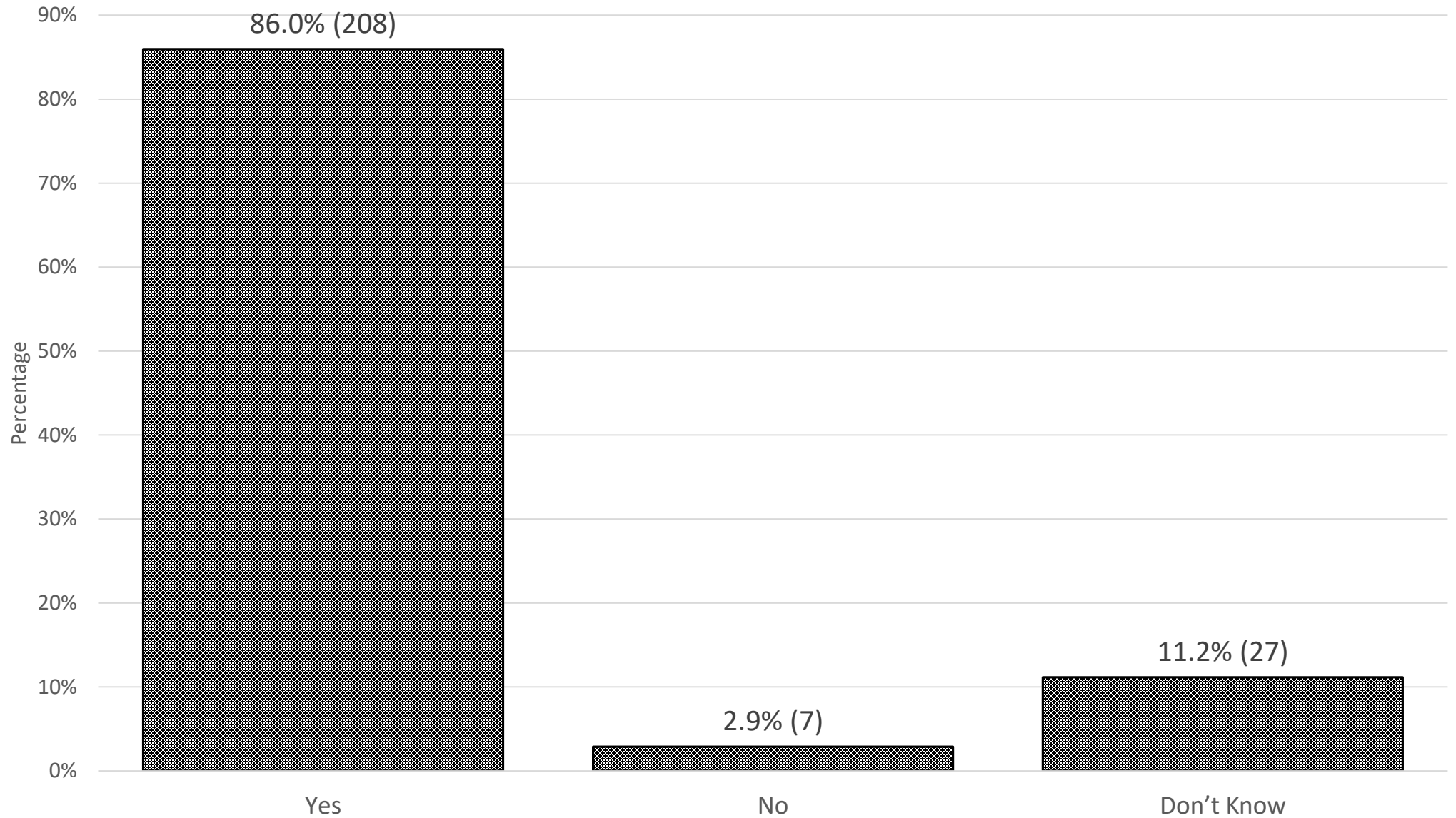

Does your household have a working Fire Extinguisher?



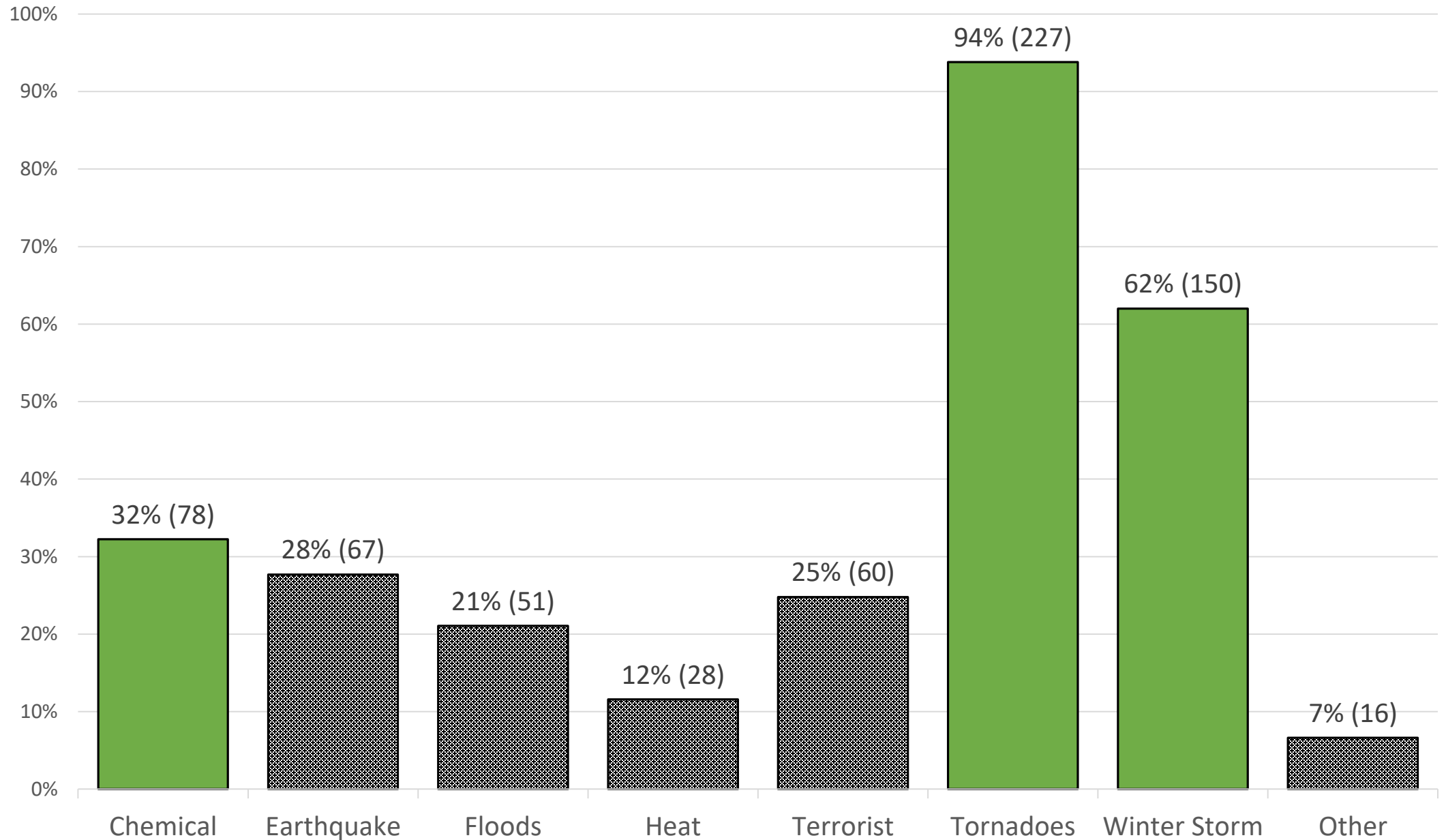

If public authorities announced a mandatory evacuation from your community, would you and your household evacuate?



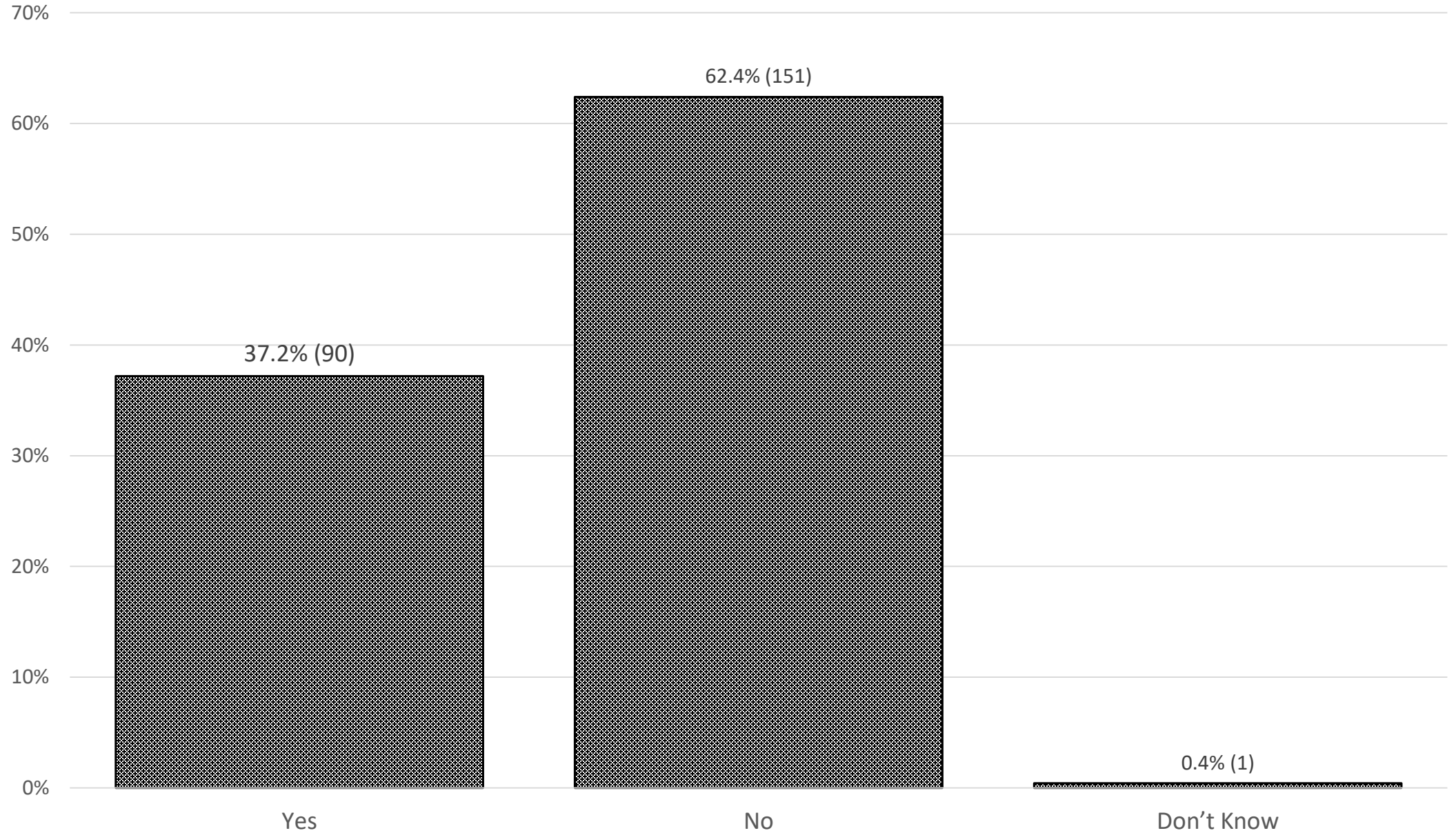

Which do you view as the 3 greatest emergency or disaster threats to your household?



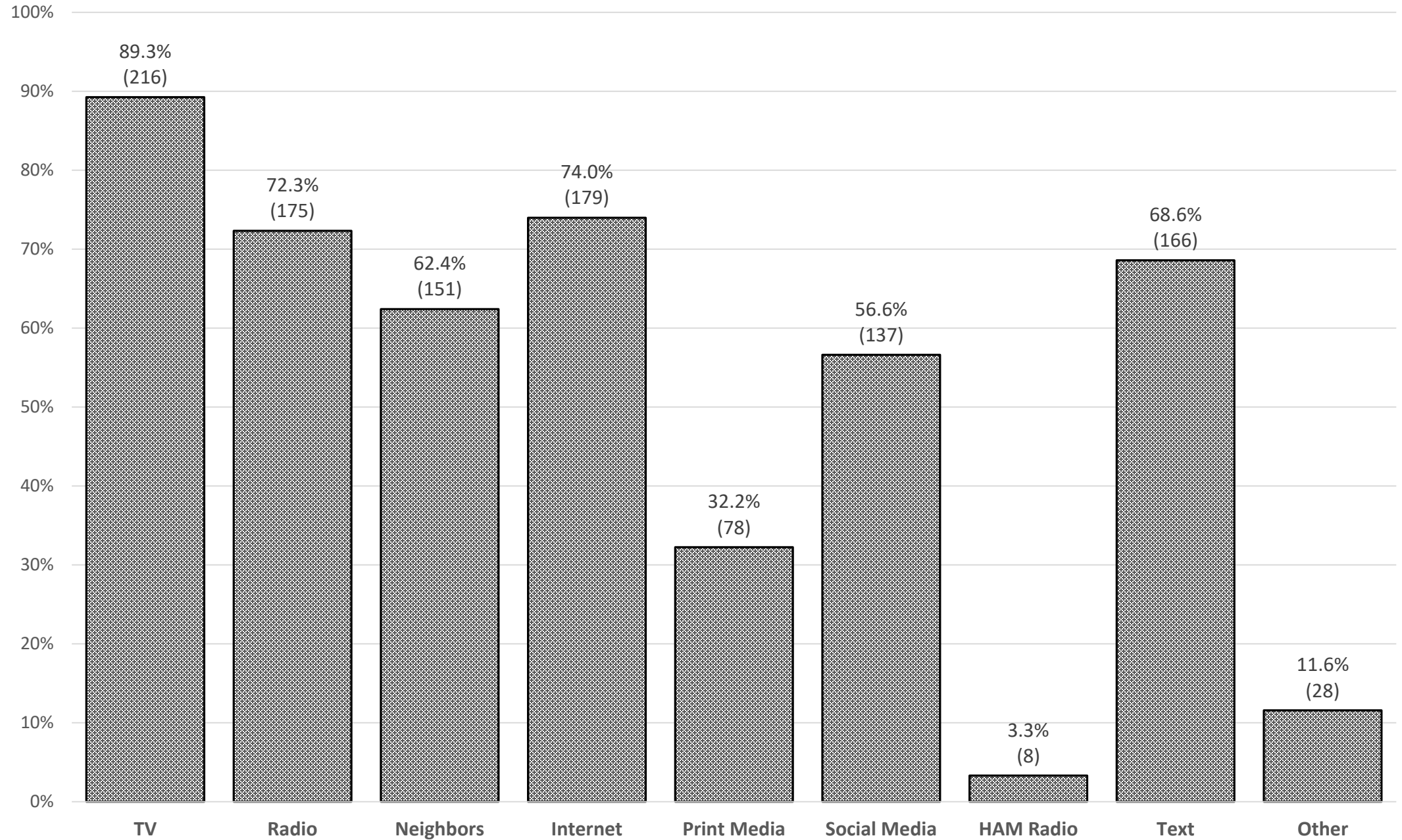

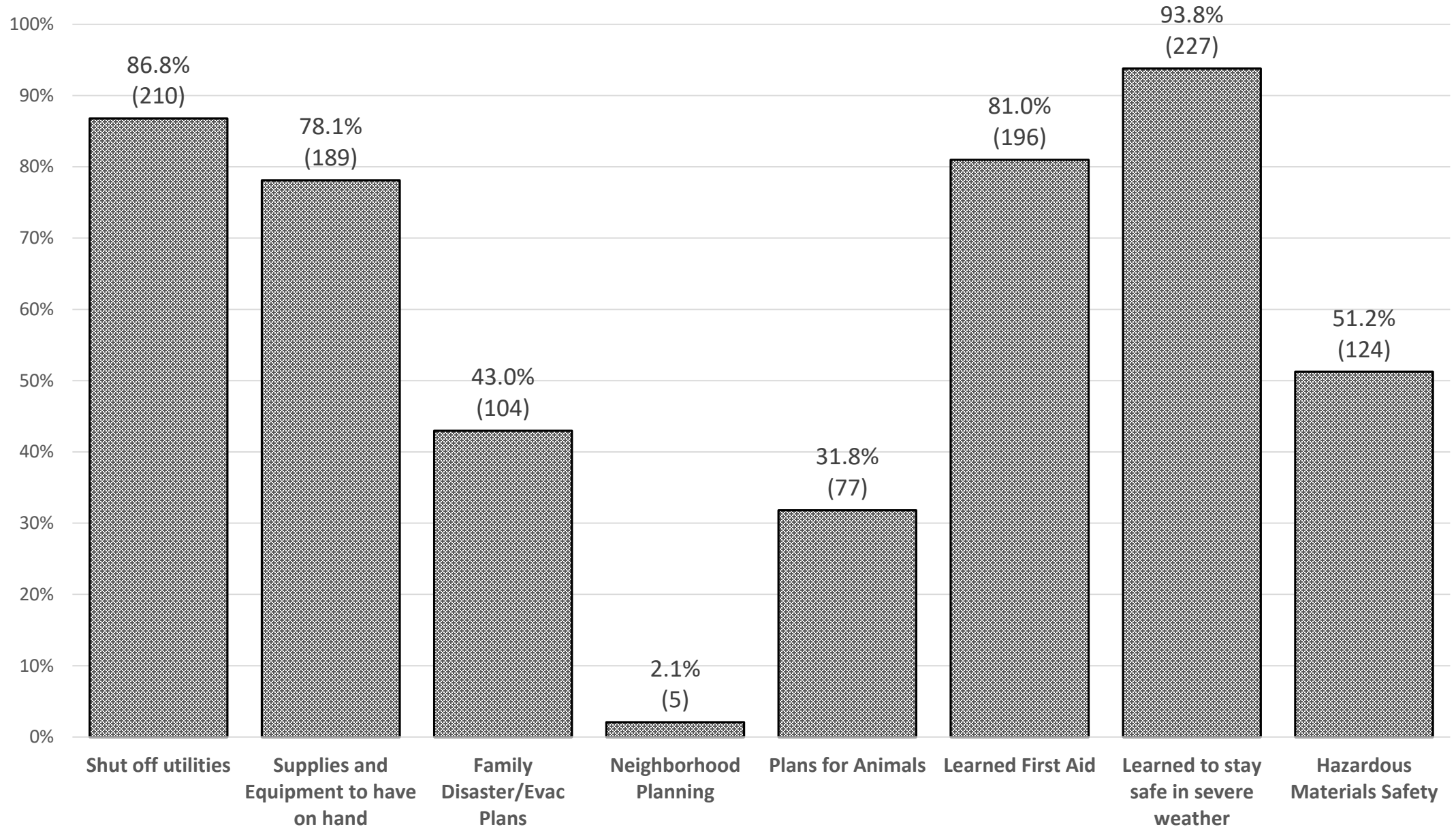

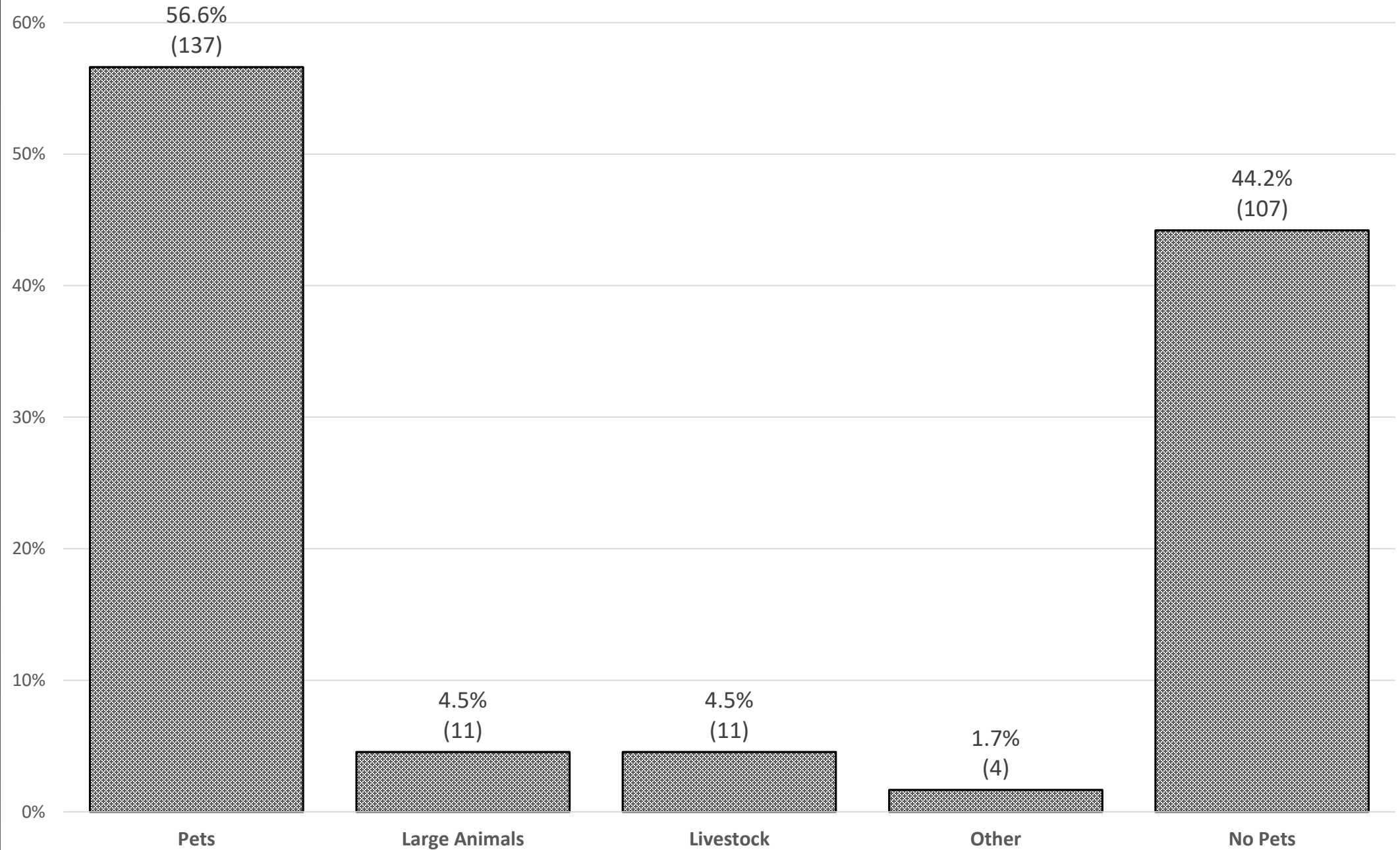

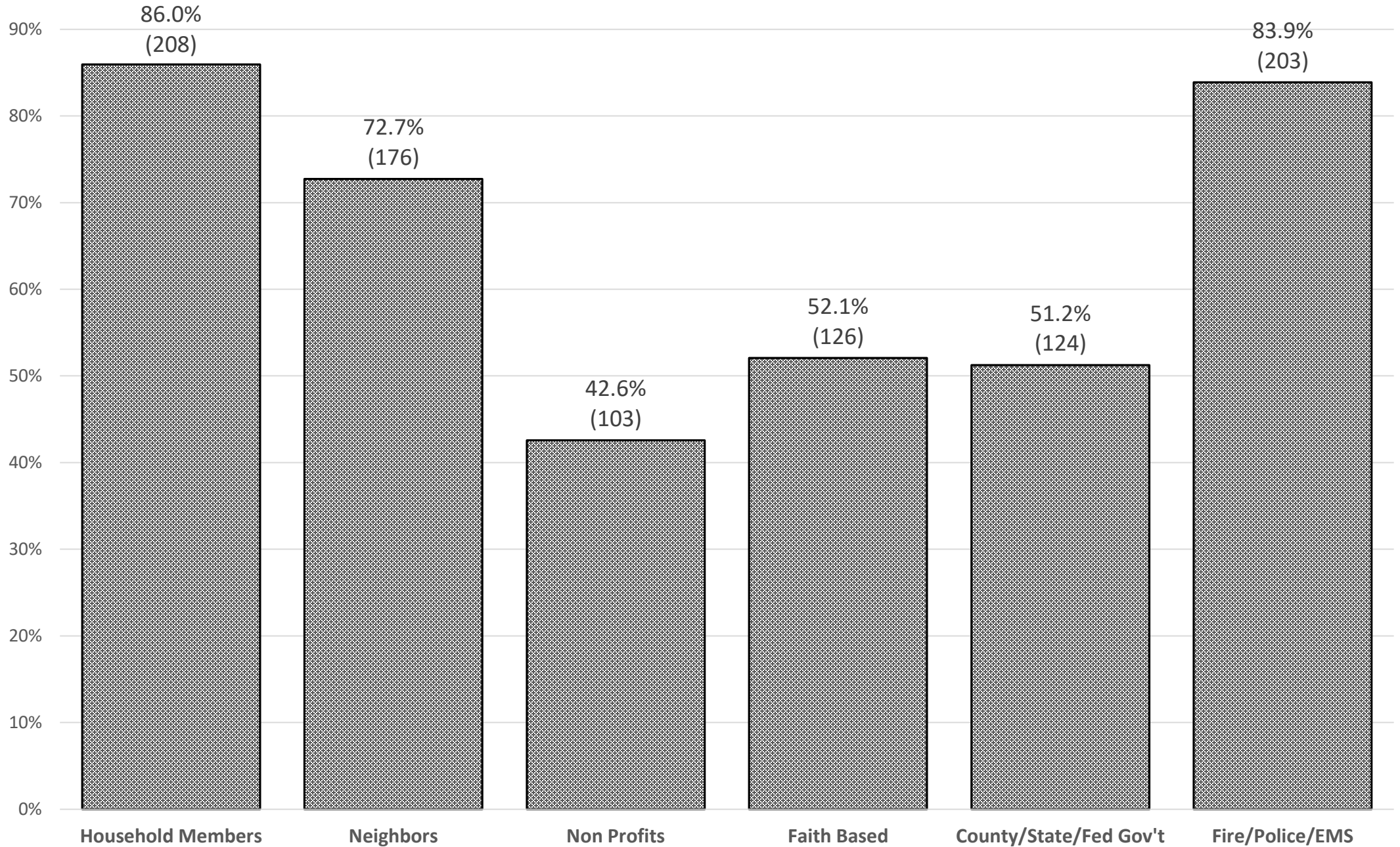

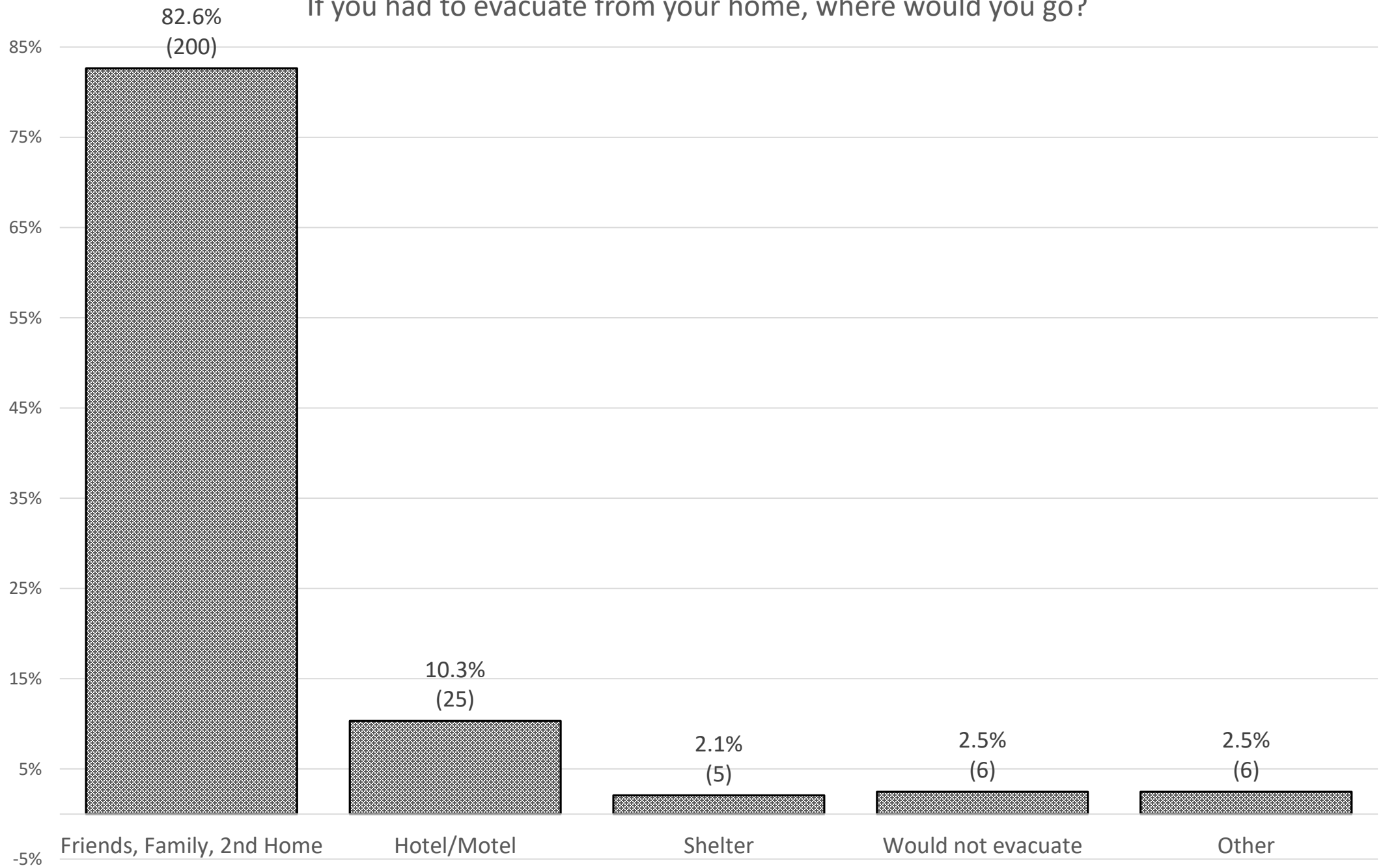

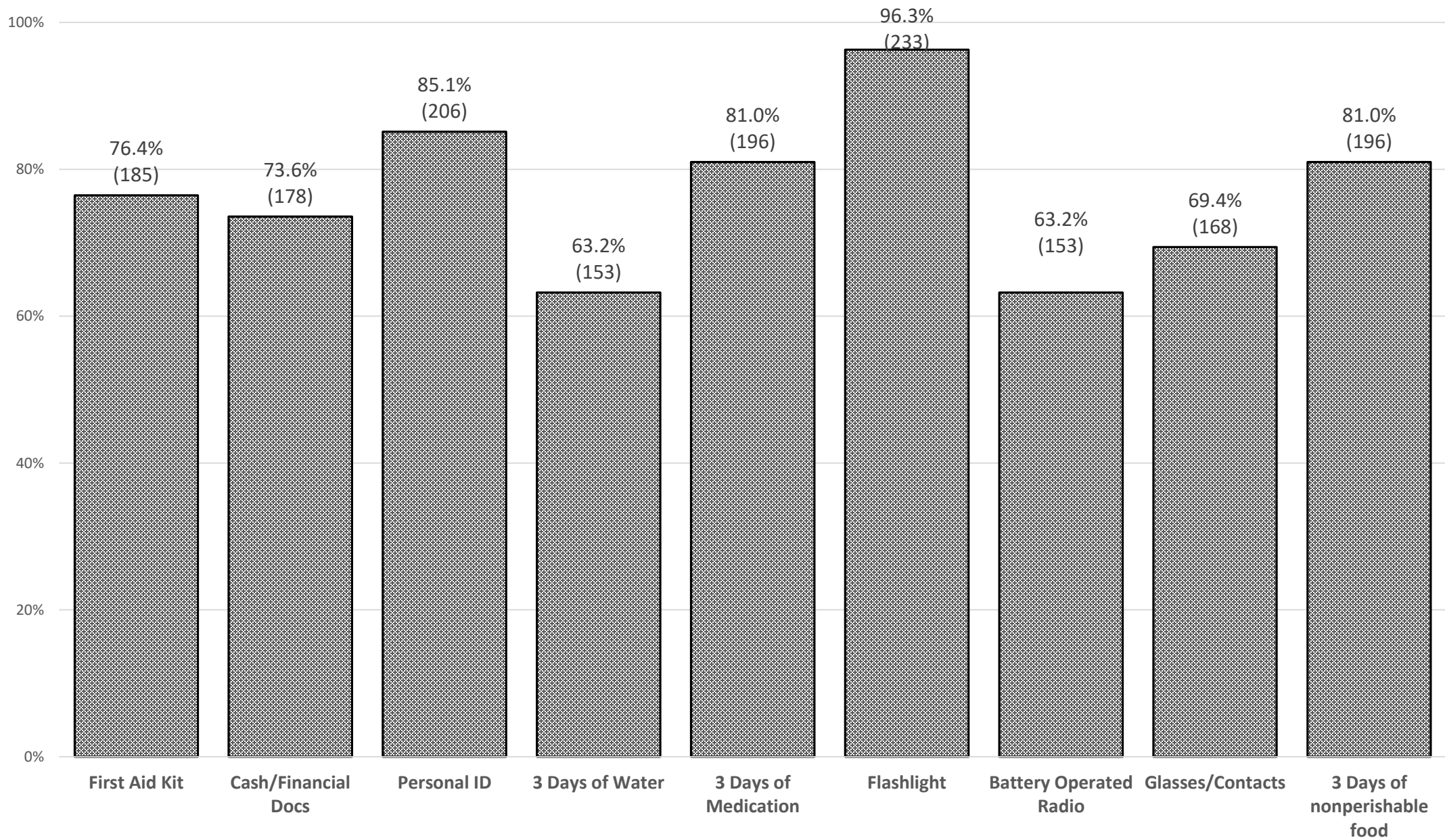

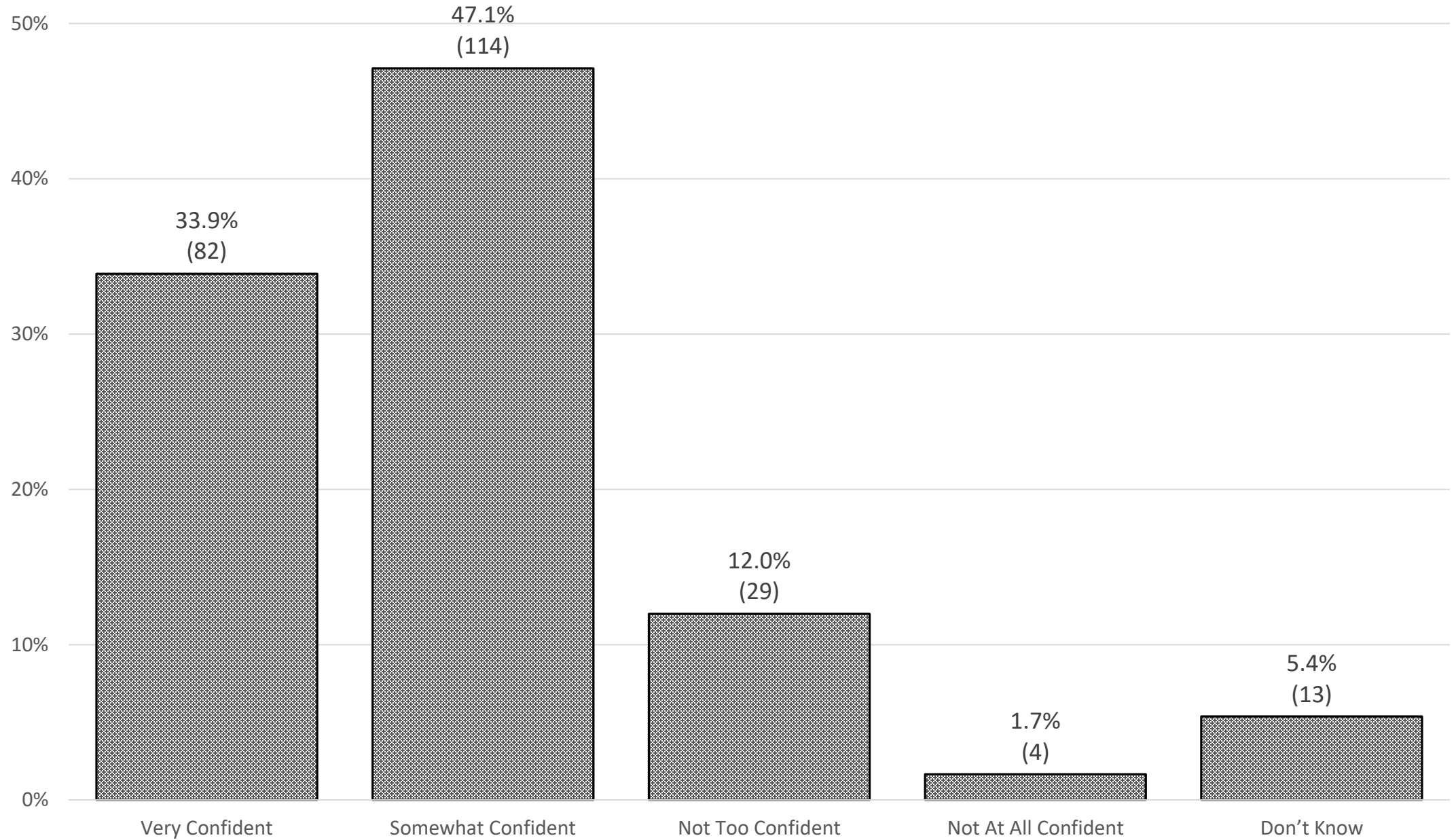

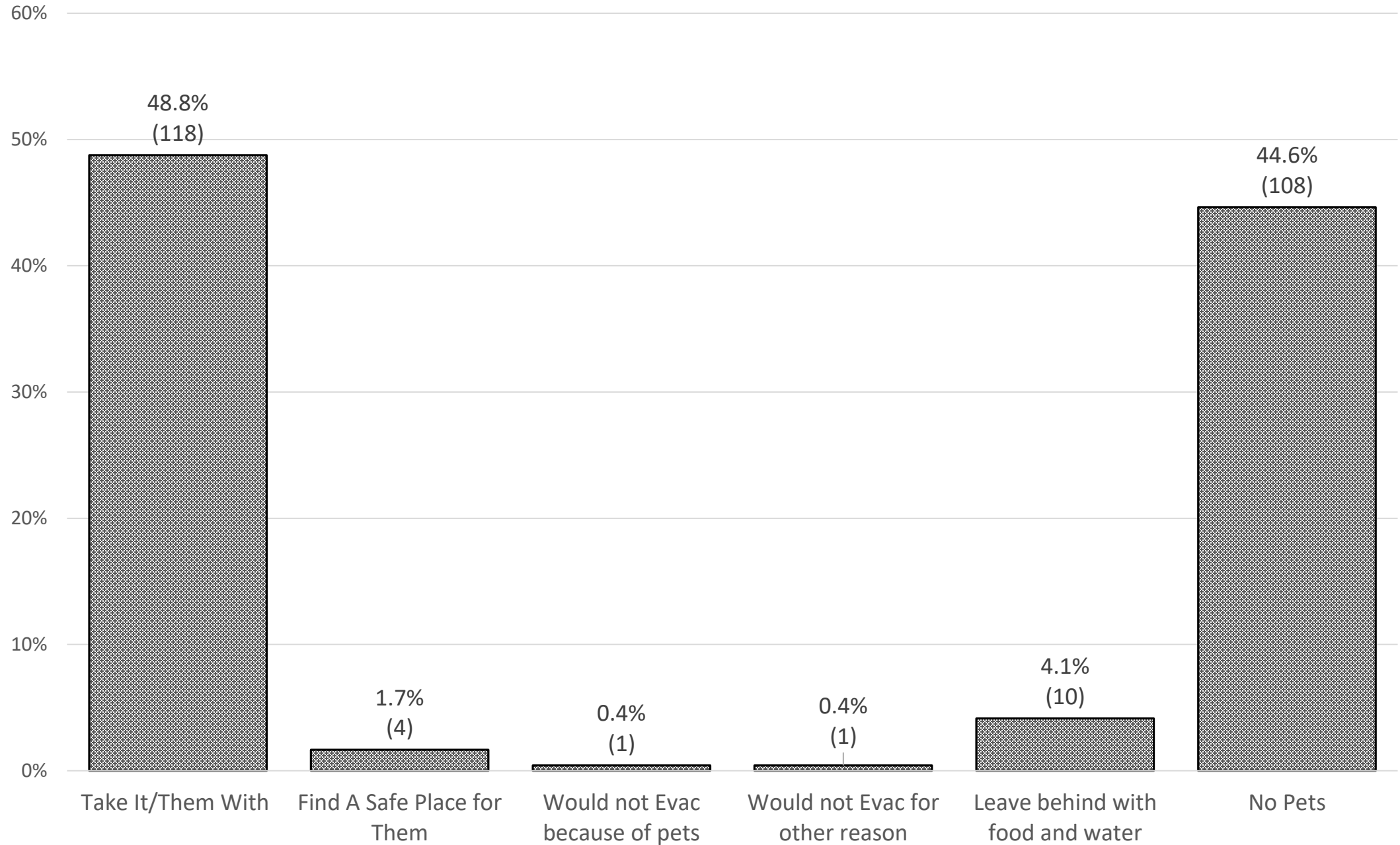

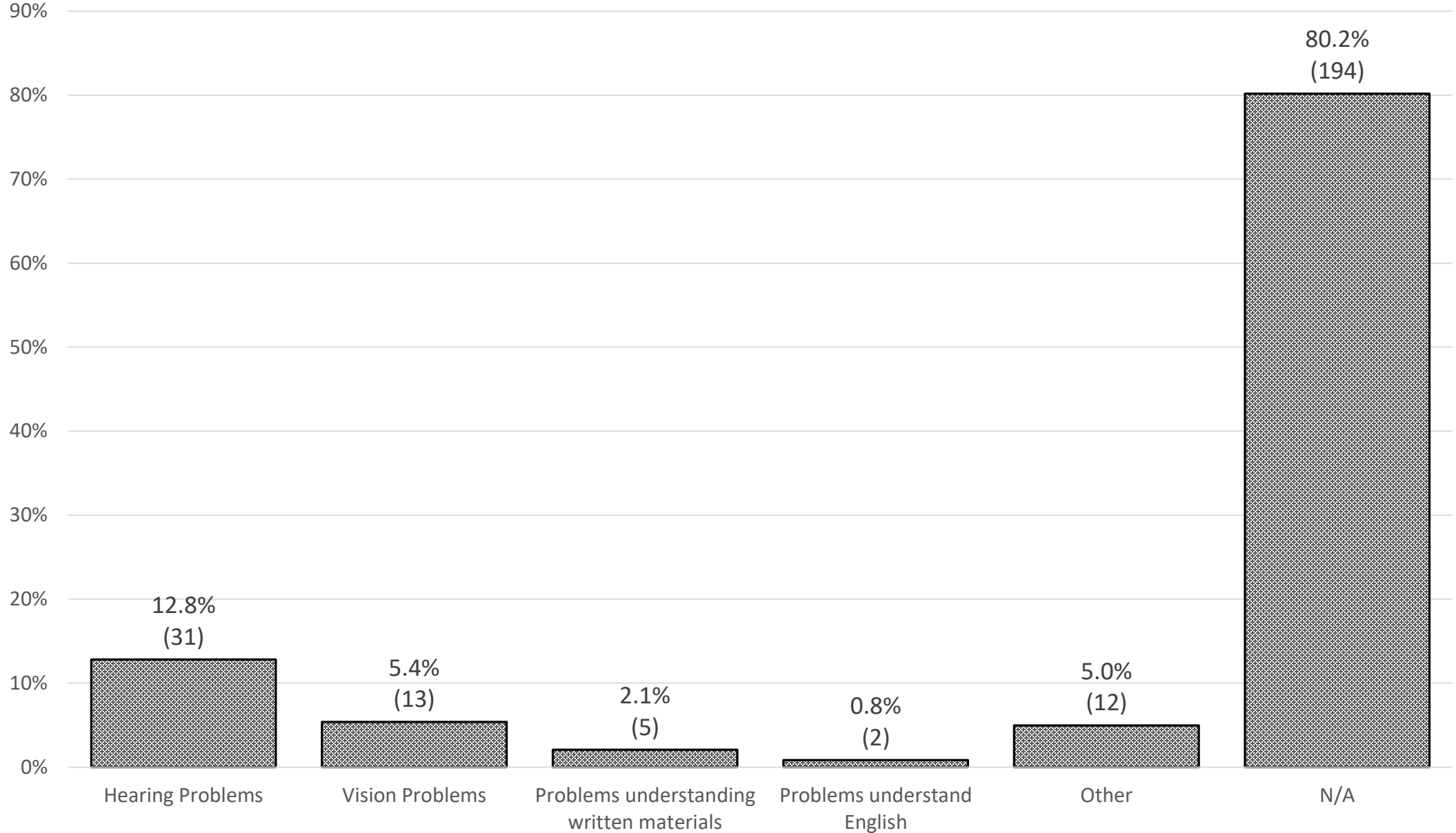

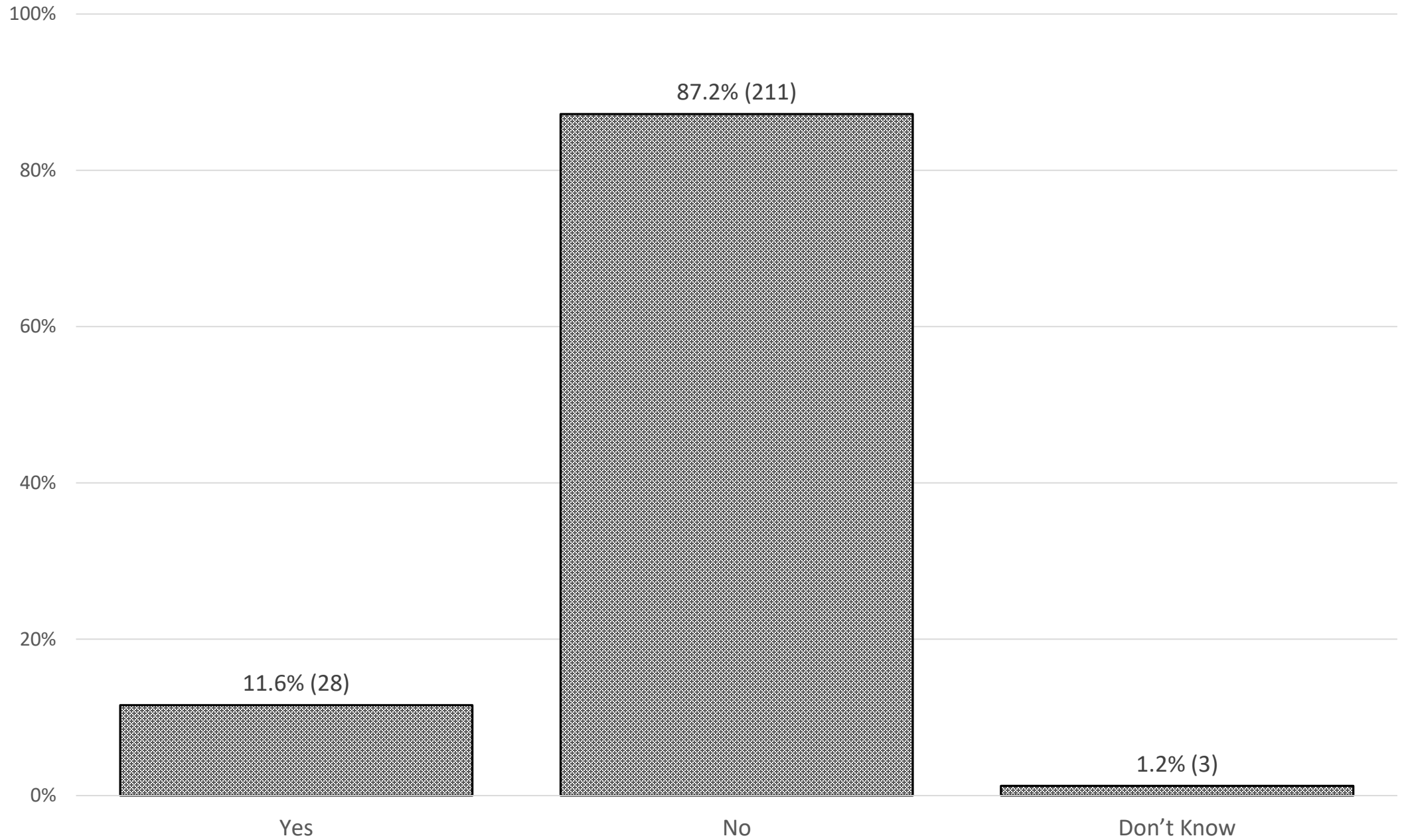

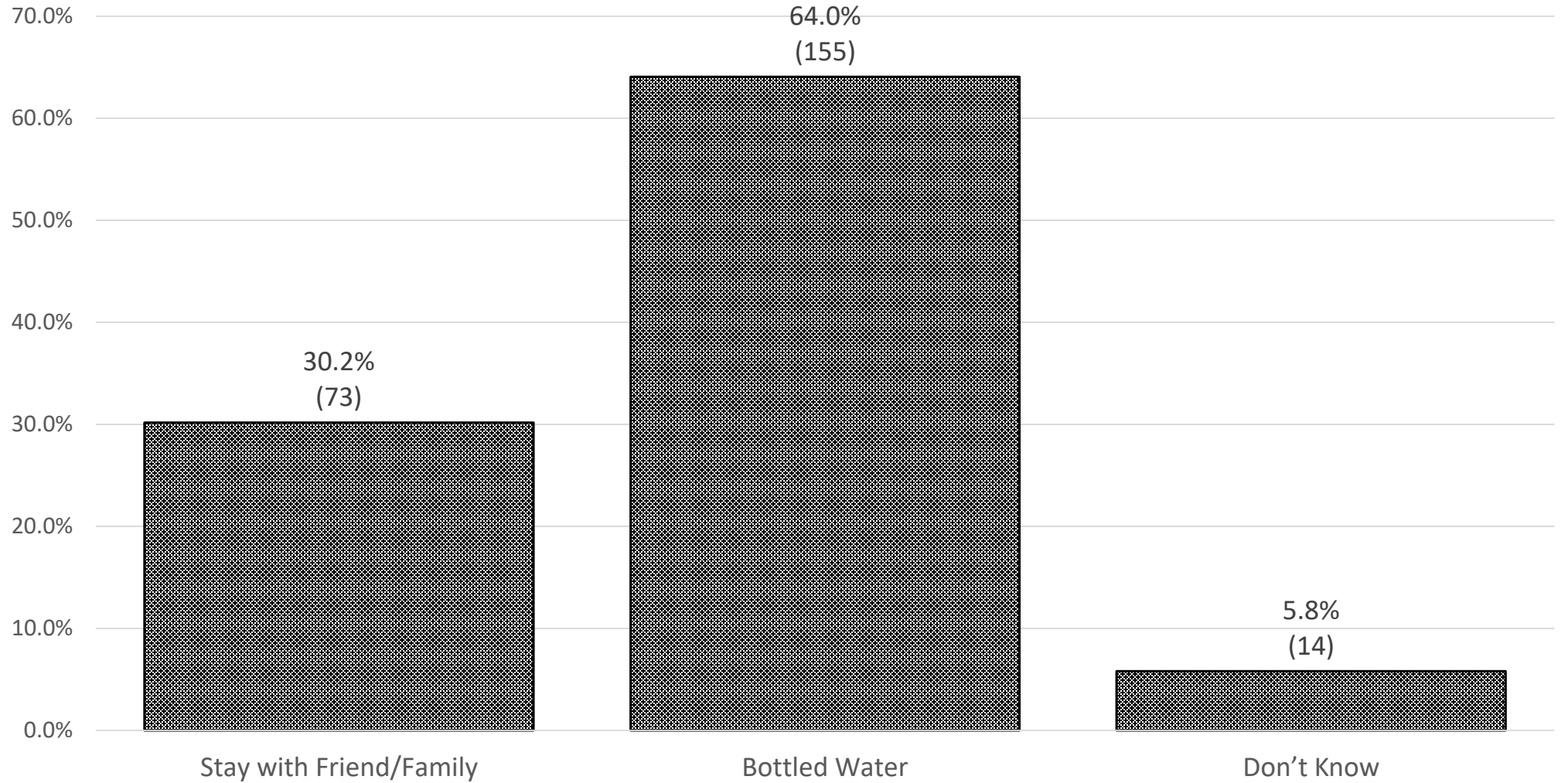

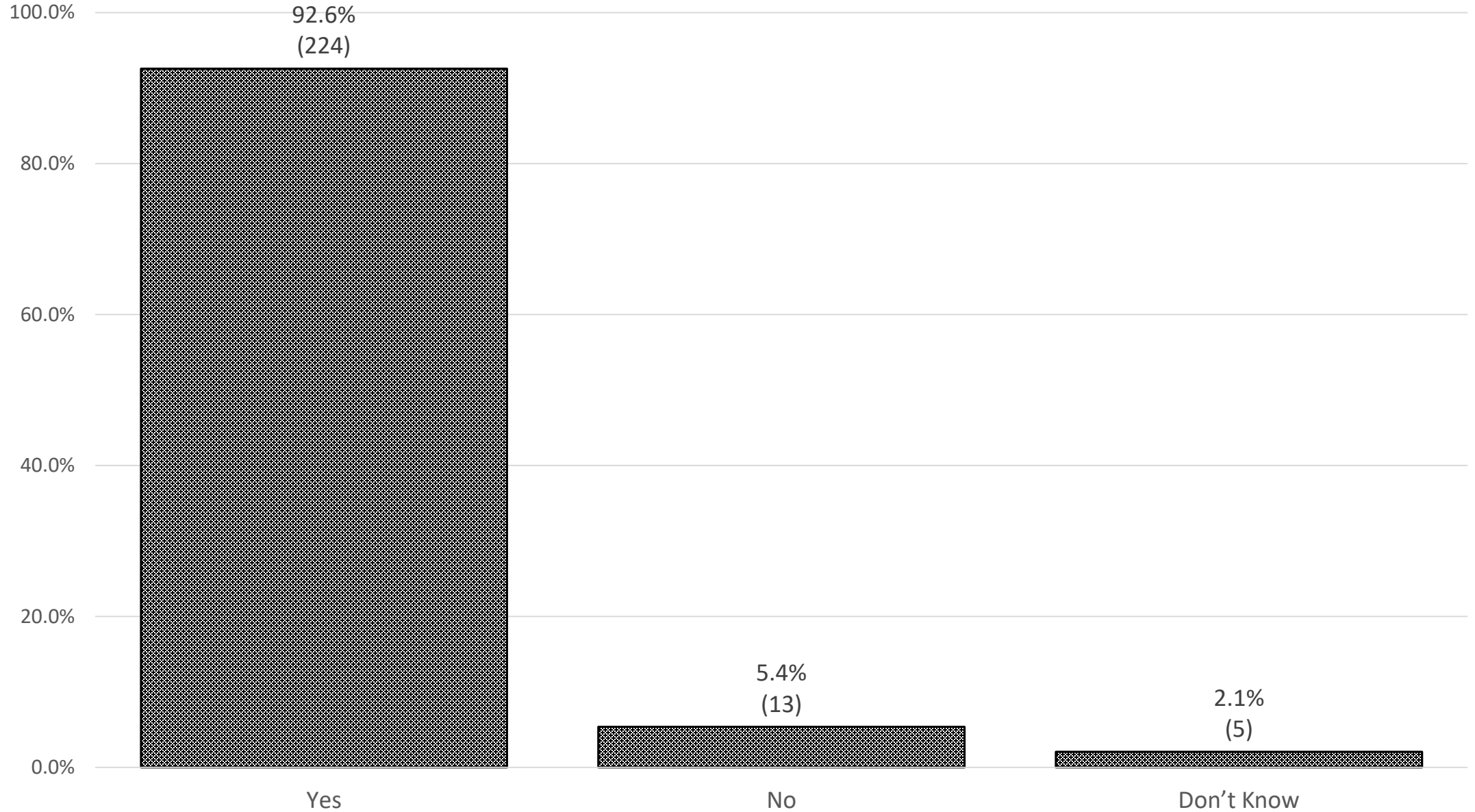

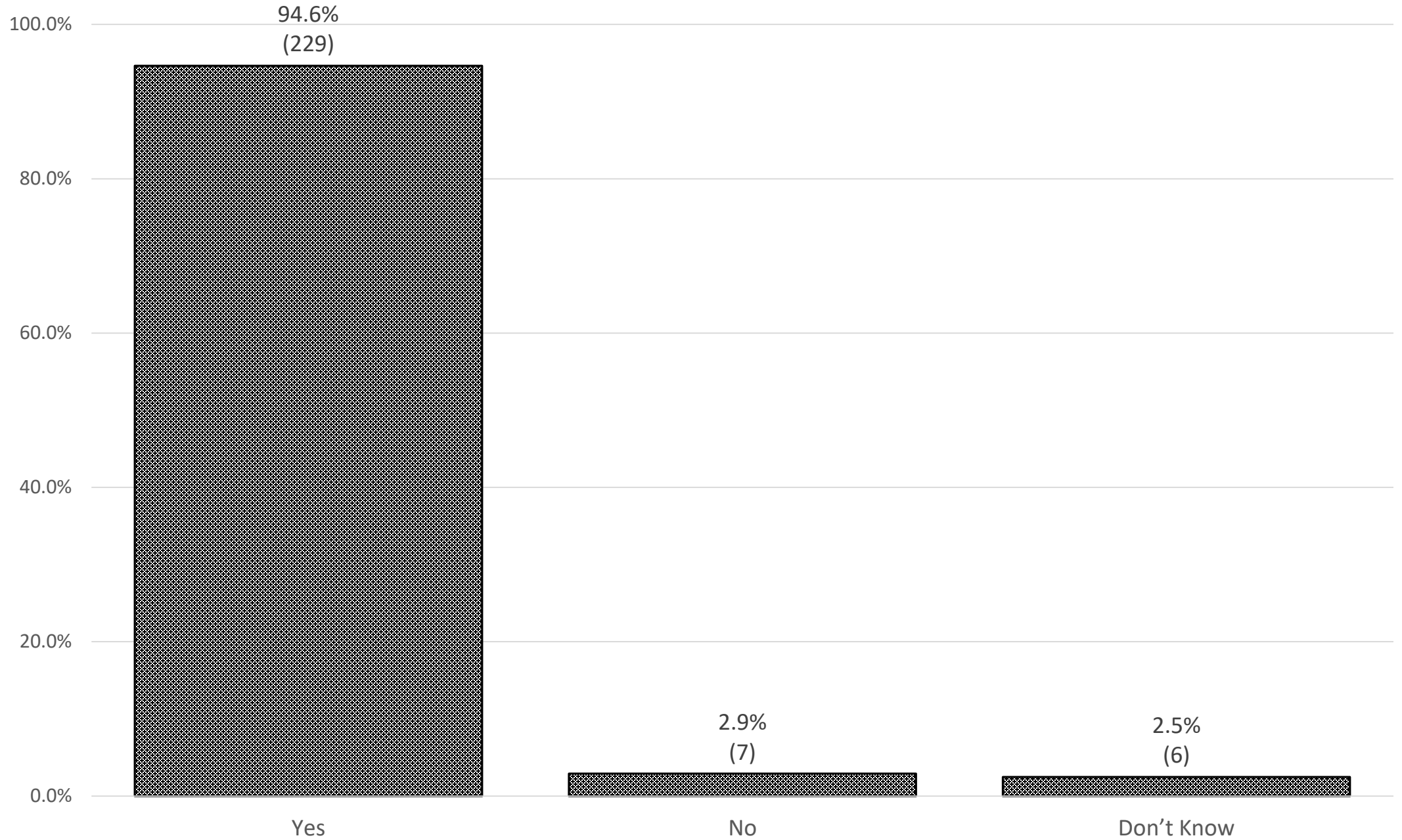

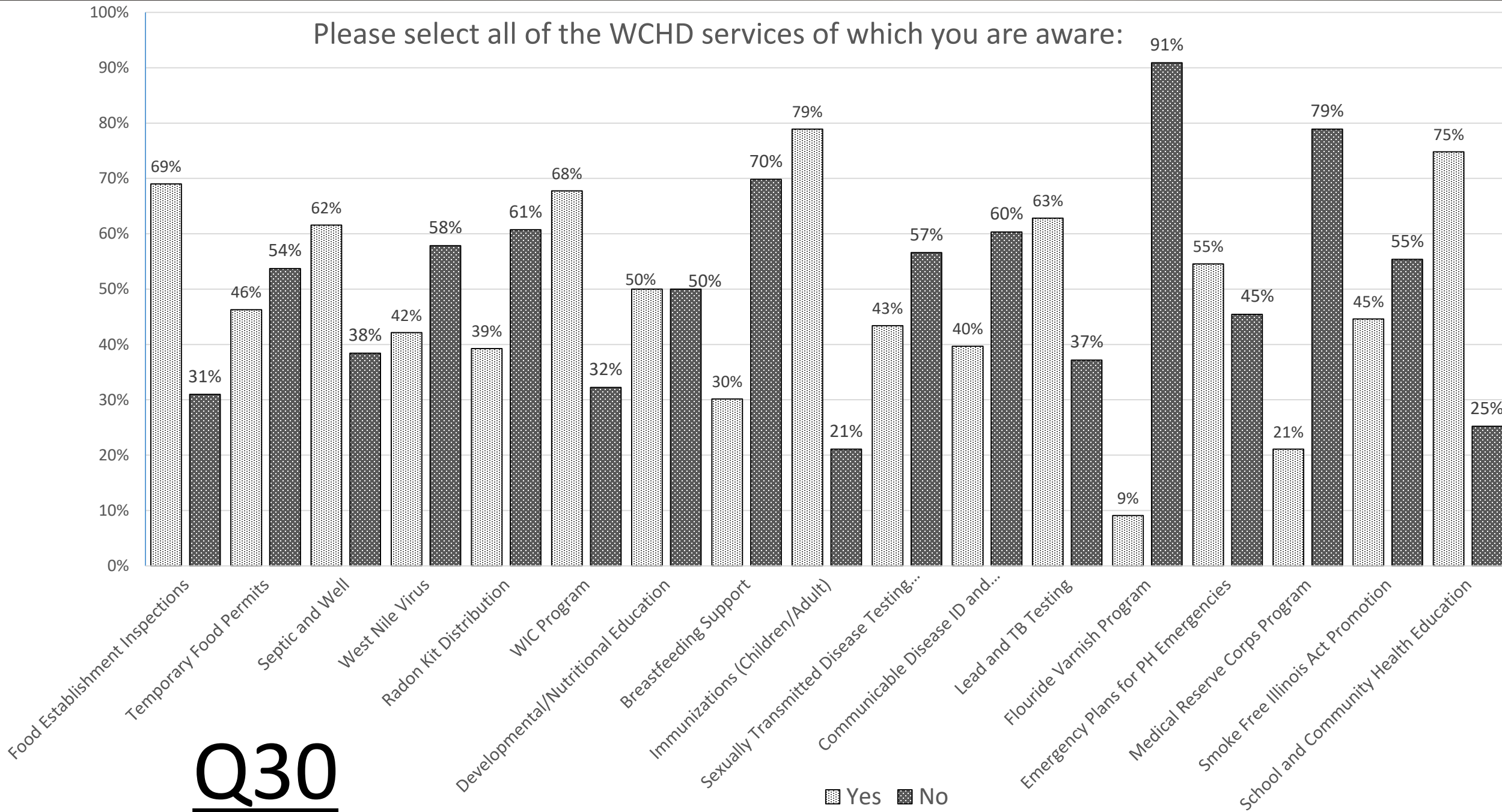
