The Woodford County Correctional Facility has contracted with Pigeonly Corrections to provide Mail Scanning services. Effective **April 12, 2021**, inmate postal mail must be sent to the following address:

These changes are being made to streamline the operations of the facility, improve communications, and ensure the safety and well-being of inmates and staff. Pigeonly offers a quick and efficient way for inmates to receive letters and photos via the U.S. Postal Service. You can also sign up for additional services through Pigeonly at www.pigeonly.com to create and send letters, postcards, photos, and more for a simple monthly rate. Use code **WOODFORD** to send your first month of mail FREE! Code valid one time use per new user.

Mail Process

The inmate's name and booking/ID number must be clearly printed on the outside of the envelope or postcard to ensure the mail is posted to the current account. All regular US Postal Service sent to an inmate (postcards, letters, greeting cards, etc.) will be scanned into a printed copy, which will be sent to the Woodford County Correctional Facility. In the future, these items will be available to the inmates to view via the Edovo tablets.

Upon release, formerly incarcerated individuals can email support@pigeon.ly with their inmate number to download their photos, messages, and scanned postal mail for FREE!

Prohibited Items

All received mail will be inspected for prohibited materials. Mail that contains the following will be flagged and is subject to being marked as undeliverable: nudity, explicit sexual material, obscene material, violent language, promotion of violence and contraband such as but not limited to weapons, drugs, or items of an unknown substance or odor.
